

A typical KS1 Small Class Day

School starts at 8.50am with a physical warm up followed by the register and a look at the visual time table for the day. Here is a typical day-

9am – Date, weather, jobs and visual timetable for day.

9.15am- Maths focus **123**

10.15am - Assembly

Play time is 10.30am to 10.45am

Milk and fruit break

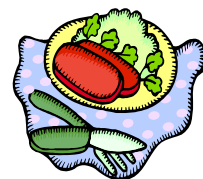
10.55am- English focus



Continuous provision areas are used throughout the day.

Dinner time is 12 O'clock until 1pm.

Sandwiches and school dinners are eaten together then the children go out to play.



1pm - Meditation, Speaking and listening activity or Letters and Sounds for about 20 minutes.

1.20pm - Topic focus eg 'Transport', 'Ourselves' or PE



2.15pm - 2.30pm afternoon play or physical activity

Topic focus continued or RE or PSHCE

3.10pm - Story time or songs

3.30pm – school ends

School starts at 8.50am with an entry activity completed whilst the register is done. Here is a typical day-

9am – Visual time table for day

9.10am- Maths focus

10.15am - Assembly

Play time is 10.30am to 10.45am

Milk and fruit break

10.55am- English focus



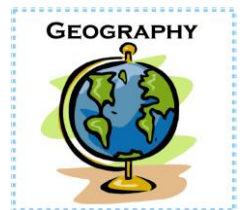
Dinner time - 12.15pm until 1.20pm.

Sandwiches and school dinners are eaten together then the children go out to play.



1.20pm – Independent reading and supported reading.

1.25pm – Subject focus eg History, Science, PE, Art/DT



There is not an official break in the afternoon, but the children often have a short break with some physical activity.

3.15pm – End of day story, discussion time or 'Newsround' on smartboard

3.30pm – school ends
