# **Update**

# **Free School Meals**

We send these vouchers out fortnightly but the government have now announced that these will also be provided for the summer holiday period. This will be as a bulk voucher for the entire holiday and will be sent at the start of it. Please let us know next week if you wish to change the supermarket where you can redeem your vouchers. #### **School Places**

We intend to increase the number of pupils in our key worker/vulnerable children 'bubbles' from Monday 6th July. Currently these have only 10 children at a time but due to increased confidence about the trend of infection rates in the Trafford area reducing over time ( this is based on public health information that we regularly receive from Trafford ) and the government's announcement that from 6th July social distancing can move to 1M + , we feel it is right to do this now. We ask that anyone who has any concerns contacts the school office so that we can explain the hygiene precautions etc that we are taking.

The additional places will mean that we can provide more spaces for key worker children and for those who are classed as vulnerable. We already have a lengthy waiting list for spaces and will offer to those parents first but encourage anyone who does require a place to let us know as soon as possible so that we can add you to our list. We are sorry that we can't have all of our pupils back at school at the moment. The government have said they will give us more information at the end of next week about how schools will return for the new school year in September. We will pass this on to you as soon as we get it.

## **Summer Holiday**

School will be closed over the summer holidays for all children. Trafford are hoping to organise some 'childcare hubs' that can be accessed by any parents needing holiday childcare. This is being organised by the Family Information Service and we will send out details to you when we get them.

### **Transition Arrangements**

The week beginning 6th July we will be sending out details of our class set up for the next academic year. We will let you know who your child's class teacher will be and detail the transition arrangements we have made so that children can say 'goodbye' to their current class teacher and 'hello' to their new class teacher. We would normally hold a 'moving on' afternoon in school where this would take place. You will understand that we can not do this at present but we will be organising opportunities through class Zoom calls. All information and links will be sent out via email on the Teachers2Parents system ( the same system used to send out weekly newsletters).

# **Libraries Re Opening**

As you are probably aware, Trafford's libraries closed on Monday 23rd March as a result of the Covid-19 pandemic and all staff were deployed, wherever possible, to support other services. As a result of the Government's statement on Tuesday 23rd June, Trafford can confirm that three libraries, **Altrincham, Sale and Urmston, will re-open from Monday 6th July**. The libraries, which have all been thoroughly cleaned, **will initially open from 10am–4pm Monday to Saturday**. They will be offering slightly different services in the first phase of re-opening to maintain the current guidelines around social distancing for the safety of our staff and customers.

### Visitors will be able to:

- return library books borrowed before the libraries closed.
- borrow more books by using the new 'Order and Collect' service.
- pre-book to use the public computers if you don't have access to computers.

Altrincham, Sale and Urmston are the largest libraries and have enough space to quarantine all returned books for 72 hours as recommended by Public Health England. Staff will ask visitors to queue outside and then will let people in on a 'one in, one out basis'. Once inside, you will be able to put books you are bringing back on trolleys located in the entrance and/or pick up your new books from a table, also in the entrance.

If you have pre-booked to use the computers, there will be a one way system to follow to ensure social distancing.


