- A one way system around the school entrances and exits to allow everyone to enter and leave safely without having to cross paths with others
- Slight changes to start and finish times for different key stages to reduce as far as possible the amount of adults/ children who are arriving and leaving at the same time (this will be within the 8.45 am to 3.30 pm window)
- Staggering of break times/use of different play areas so that different 'bubbles' of children do not mix
- Arrangement for any children who may feel particularly anxious about returning to have a 5 minute walk through their new classroom prior to school opening on 3rd September


If any updates are needed to this information, in the light of any further government guidance being received during the holiday period, we will send this out to parents.
