#### Changes to First Aid attention in school

Our Teachers and Teaching Assistants are trained in basic first aid with some staff also trained as Paediatric First Aiders. Instead of sending all children to the Office, our staff will now triage any incidents as they happen and decide if further treatment is needed. We expect children to have scrapes and bumps as part of the normal school day and most children just need a little attention and sympathy from an adult and are then happy to return to play/class.

If a child does need more significant medical attention, he/she will go to the office medical area. If necessary, Staff will then complete a first aid slip detailing what happened and the first aid given. A significant bump to the head will continue to require a phone call home.




