Dear Parents and Carers,

Like other schools in the borough, we have a uniform for many reasons. It creates a sense of belonging and an identity to our school community. A uniform means our pupils don't need to worry about peer pressure when it comes to their clothes. We want our pupils to respect our uniform and we ask that you support us in regards to encouraging your child to wear the correct uniform to school.

At Acre Hall, we want our pupils to look smart but it is important that they feel comfortable. As part of being an inclusive school, we know that some of our pupils will find some uniform items constrictive. With this in mind, we have made a conscious effort to have a more flexible approach to our uniform policy.

Nursery Class

- Pale blue polo shirt (with school logo optional)
- Navy tracksuit
- Comfortable shoes/trainers
- Wellington boots and suitable coat for wet weather play

Reception Class

- Pale blue polo shirt
- Navy school jumper or cardigan (dark navy with purple stripe around neck- optional)
- Grey skirt or trousers/shorts
- Navy/grey socks or tights for wearing with a skirt
- Black school shoes or plain black trainers at all times

Years 1 - 6

- Pale blue shirt or pale blue polo shirt (logo optional)
- School tie (optional)
- Navy blue school cardigan or jumper (dark navy with purple stripe around the neck)
- Grey skirt/shorts/trousers
- Blue gingham summer dress (for warmer weather)
- Navy/grey socks or tights
- Black shoes or plain black trainers

PE Kit - Years 1-6

- Navy shorts/navy skort/leggings
- Pale blue t- shirt with logo (optional)

- Pumps/trainers
- Navy tracksuit with the school logo is available to purchase as an additional item for outdoor PE

 optional.
- For pupils who are required to cover arms, they may wear a **navy** tracksuit top or long sleeve **navy** 'skin' under their PE t-shirt

Hair/Jewellery

- Long hair must be tied back
- Hair colours, (including dip dye) are not permitted
- False nails, nail varnish and make-up are not permitted
- If your child has pierced ears, they may wear one pair of plain ear studs in their lower ear lobe.
 We ask that hoops aren't worn as a safety precaution. Earrings, MUST be removed on PE days. Staff are not allowed to do this for your child.
- Eyebrow shavings are not permitted
- Pupils may wear a watch. Although we would advise against pupils wearing expensive watches.
- Only religious jewellery may be worn, E.g. A Rakhi or Kara (These can be taped on PE days for safety)

PLEASE ENSURE THAT ALL UNIFORM ITEMS <u>ARE CLEARLY LABELLED</u> WITH YOUR CHILD'S NAME. Children are expected to take responsibility for their clothing. Many of our pupils will not know which cardigan/jumper is theirs. Staff are not able to identify your child's items of clothing unless they are clearly labelled with your child's name.

School Uniform Information

All items of Acre Hall school uniform can be purchased from <u>Monkhouse.com</u> or are available through the Monkhouse shops – see website for details. You are advised to contact the Monkhouse shop before visiting to check if items are in stock. **Non logo items such as navy jumpers/pale blue shirts can be purchased from other stores.**
